- The development of trench warfare
- Trench construction
- The nature of trench warfare
- Life in the trenches
- Health and hygiene in the trenches
- Illness, injuries and treatment on the Western Front
- Battlefield wounds; medical treatment on the battlefield
- The casualty evacuation process: the front line to Blighty

Bury St Edmunds Cemetery

A guided tour of selected Great War burials

Themes covered may include:

- Why were these men buried in the UK?
- Where are the majority of those who died in the Great War buried?
- Ethos and role of the Commonwealth War Graves Commission
- War in the air and at sea
- The Home Front
- WW1 Veterans after the war
