The Cannock Chase training complex – overview from one of the Hut Volunteers; How were new recruits turned into soldiers?; What were they taught? An opportunity for the group to see period equipment and weaponry.

Cannock Chase War Cemetery

Military burials in the Great War; Where are the majority of those who died in the Great War buried? Why are these men buried in the UK?The creation and ethos of the Commonwealth War Graves Commission; Boy soldiers in the Great War; Why are there German soldiers buried here?

Cannock Chase German Military Cemetery

The German Army of 1914, Regulars and Reserves, Student Battalions; The ethos of the Volksbund; The experience of Germans living in the UK during the Great War; War in the Air.

The Staffordshire Regiment Museum

Museum and recreation of a trench system; Trench warfare and trench construction; Daily routine and problems with trench fighting; The Casualty Evacuation process; developments in the treatment of wounds and injuries.
